## Free Publicity in 5 Minutes a Day

- Journalists are always looking for quotes, answers, and short interviews from “experts” in all sorts of niches.
- HelpAReporter.com is a great service that you can sign-up for free where a few times a day reporters ask questions that you can easily answer the relevant ones in minutes.
- They then pick the ones they like to use, which can get you tons of free publicity and traffic.
- Other things that can help here is having a relevant LinkedIn profile, blog (for Google searches from them looking for experts), a book on Amazon, etc..



# The Split Personality Q&A Trick

- Q&A sites like Yahoo Answers or Quora are great for not only finding leads, but having those answers rank with the relevant keywords in the questions.
  - [Answers.yahoo.com](http://Answers.yahoo.com)
  - [Quora.com](http://Quora.com)
- Searching these or using the Q&A finder in WebFire can help identify good questions to answer, which is completely white hat and recommended.
- However, there's a "grey hat" trick that can work...
- For example: Have two accounts on Yahoo Answers – ask a question on one and answer on another. 😊 (tips)



## Sharing Short Presentations

- Another way to get content out there that can rank well is by sharing slides / documents like PowerPoints, PDF's, etc.
- SlideShare.net is a great place that lets you upload such content and share it, which it then can not only help rank some really well, but some sites automatically share relevant slides for you automatically through it.
- Catchy, keyword rich titles / headlines work best, and then short 10 slide / page presentations (not a ton of text – even one liners are good, as well as a mix of graphics).
- The more they pop, the better.
- Best for explaining simple concepts that people might search for.
- Some slides can get hundreds of thousands of views or more if the topic is right.
